- 1. Applications must be submitted by the deadline. Deadline for 2018 internships is February 1, 2018.
- 2. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age.
- 3. FamilyFarms Charities will do their best to pair applicants and host farms based on compatibility.
- 4. Host Farms must agree to provide the Intern with a Mentor assigned to the Intern for the term of the internship.
- 5. Host Farm will provide lodging and one meal per day for Intern as a part of the program.
- 6. Host Farm will agree to pay Intern minimum wage.
- 7. FamilyFarms Charities will assist in the funding of food and lodging by providing \$350 per month to Host Farm with a maximum of \$1050 per internship.
- 8. FamilyFarms Charities will sponsor a maximum of 5 internships per year.
- 9. Intern is responsible for their travel to and from the Host Farm at the beginning and end of Internship.
- 10. If Intern requires transportation during internship, Intern and Host Farm shall be responsible for making these arrangements prior to the start of the internship.
- 11. Host Farms agree to write a description of what is to be learned and expectations for Intern during internship.
- 12. All parties agree to complete surveys provided about the experience to FamilyFarms Charities.
